To be judged on the child's ability and knowledge of cleaning and grooming procedures, as well as showmanship. Age to be taken into consideration. All divisions will be shown simultaneously. No foals allowed. Only one child to a pony/horse. All children and ponies/horses will enter the ring at the same time and adults or helpers may accompany them into the ring to carry their grooming equipment but must leave before the judging begins. The children will be divided into the respective age groups and the ponies/horses tied to the fence. The children must have their own grooming equipment with them and no ponies/horses may enter the ring braided. Children should be clean, tidy and dress to groom, not to ride.
