SPECIAL RULES

1. Animals not properly identified or an animal with unhealed ear notches will be ineligible for premiums.
2. All mature sows should show evidence of having suckled young offspring within 12 months prior to the show day.
3. Animals shown in 4H/FFA classes under the members name cannot be shown in the open classes in the name of the parents or farm name.
4. **Open Swine Schedule:**
 - Pens available – 9M, Thursday, September 3rd
 - Must be in place – 12Noon, Friday, September 4th
 - Barrows will be weighed 1PM on Friday, September 4th
 - Must be checked-in – 1PM to 5PM, Friday, September 4th**
 - Released - 8PM, Monday, September 7th**
5. All animals must be fed inside their pen.
6. The Superintendent will assign pens.
7. Registration certificates for each animal must be furnished and available anytime during the fair. Certificates will be checked prior to show day. All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor.
8. All barrows must have been farrowed on or after February 1, 2008. Purebreds sire and dam must be registered. Exhibitor must own them.
9. No moneys are awarded to champions.
10. Wood shavings will be the initial bedding.
11. All animals must be the property of the Exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the show.
12. All registration papers MUST be checked between 1PM and 5PM on Friday, September 4th, 2009 – Animals will be omitted from showing if not checked.
13. To be eligible to show crossbred Barrows and Gilts, exhibitor must show purebred breeding stock.
14. Crossbred Market classes are open to Barrows only. Gilts must show in gilt classes, which are D13 through D22 and are not eligible for classes D24 – D33.
15. The Champion Crossbred Gilt will not be eligible for the Supreme Champion class.
16. Whether or not an individual has the ability to show a boar is up to/determined by the Superintendent or Ringman (minimum age being 13).
17. Animals must follow NSR and/or other breed association rules for the show. Will be at the discretion of the judge and the superintendent, when the animals enter the ring.
