Grain

Not inspected for Certification

All grain judged on appearance only. Exhibitors are limited to 1 entry in each class in this section. Exhibit consists of 1 quart.

Variety must be named.

- A1 Wheat
- A2 Barley
- A3 Oats
- A4 Rye
- A5 Soybeans, black
- A6 Soybeans, yellow

Corn

The name of the hybrid must be given when the exhibit is entered. Corn will be judged as to feed quality only. Stalk corn exhibits will be judged on the basis of ear and stalk quality, freedom from disease and insect damage. Ear corn and shelled corn exhibits to be from last years crop - 2009. Exhibitors are limited to 1 entry in each class in this section.

- A7 Ten ears feed corn
- A8 One quart shelled feed corn
- A9 Six stalks ensilage corn
- A10 Six stalks field corn

Sheaf of Unthreshed Grain

100-head sample, straw length at least 10". All varieties of each crop will be grouped together in one class, but each entry must be labeled as to variety. Exhibitors are limited to 1 entry in each class in this section.

Hay

Hay must be cured below 20% moisture and the bundle obtained from the center of the bale. "First Cutting" entries shall be from stands at least 1 year old. Entries from new seedlings (stands less than 1 – year old) shall be entered as "Later Cutting". The dimensions of the bundle should be approximately 18" x 18" x 6". Bundles must be tied tightly 4 ways, since they may be hung over other displays. Exhibitors may enter in as many classes as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than one entry in a class, either in his own name, the name of the farm, or the name of some other person.

- A15 Alfalfa – First Cutting
Alfalfa with not over 10% grasses
- A16 Alfalfa – Later Cutting
Alfalfa with not over 10% grasses
- A17 Alfalfa/Grass mixed – First Cutting
A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 % but not over 50% grasses

Hay (cont.)

- A18 Alfalfa/Grass mixed – Later Cutting
A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10% but not over 50% grasses
- A19 Clover
Clover with not over 20% grasses
- A20 Clover/Grass Mixed
A mixture of clover and grass with over 20% but not over 50% grasses
- A21 Timothy – First Cutting
From stand at least 1 – year old
- A22 Other Grass – First Cutting
Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10% legume
- A23 Grass – Later Cutting
Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10% legume
- A24 Mixed Hay – More than 50% Legumes
Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50% or more legumes in combination with grasses
- A25 Mixed Hay – More than 50% Grasses
Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50% or more grass in combination with alfalfa, clover, or birdsfoot trefoil

- A32 Sugar beets, 3 (topped)
- A33 Yellow popcorn, 10 ears
- A34 Indian corn, 10 ears
- A35 Ornamental popcorn, 6 ears

Tobacco

All samples must contain 3 bundles. Each bundle to contain 12 leaves not including the tie leaf. The leaves must be pressed but not ironed. All samples must be from the 2009 Maryland tobacco crop. Only 1 sample permitted per exhibitor.
