

SECTION B – FRUITS

Entry Time – Tuesday, August 25th, 2010, from 1PM to 8PM, and Wednesday, August 26th, 2010, from 9AM to 8PM.

1. Each exhibitor is limited to 2 entries per class, Except in Fruit Displays where only 1 entry is allowed.
2. All fruit exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor.
3. Judges recommend that all fruits be entered in a less than full-ripened condition so they will remain in good condition for the 11-day duration of the fair.

Basis for Judging

1. Shape and average size for variety.
2. Color, condition and uniformity of fruit form.
3. Freedom from defects and blemishes caused by insects, bruises, sun scald or spray burn.
4. Any entry may be disqualified if specified number of fruits is not included or if there is a mixture of varieties in the entry.
