Division Rules & Regulations: The fitting and preparation of all animals for exhibit is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors may receive guidance only from immediate family members, Maryland 4-H/FFA Members and appointed MCE Volunteers/FFA Advisors.

1. Exhibitors and their exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", "Animal Rules & Regulations", the "Maryland 4-H Code of Animal Science Ethics", the "Health Regulations for Livestock Exhibited in Maryland", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations".
2. **Entries:** Entries will be received beginning at 7 am on Friday, August 24th in the Cow Palace. **All animals must be in place by 12:00 noon on Friday, August 24th.** Exhibitors must remain in the stalls assigned to them by the Superintendent. **DO NOT BRING TACK/DECOR BEFORE Wednesday, August 22nd. DO NOT BRING ANIMALS BEFORE FRIDAY, AUGUST 24th!** Refer to "Schedule of Events" and "4-H/FFA Exhibit Entry Information" for additional information.

Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEMS FOUND AT www.marylandstatefair.com** Internet entries are due **July 31ST**. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release forms are to be completed online through the entry system at time of registration. Reminder you must have completed your Quality Assurance to be able to exhibit your animals. Check with your county to make sure you are up to date with this requirement.

3. **Ownership:** All Feeder Dairy Steer animals exhibited must be owned, registered and tagged and weighed with a Maryland 4-H tag in the Exhibitor's name only by June 1 of the current year and be under one year of age. All Market Dairy Steers must be owned by January 1st. **ALL MARKET DAIRY STEERS MUST BE BORN AFTER JANUARY 1 OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR. (TO SHOW IN 2018 – MUST BE BORN AFTER Jan 1, 2017).**
4. Steers will be weighed and must be tagged with a MD 4-H Livestock Tag. Weighing is 12:30pm – 2:00pm, Friday, August 24th immediately following beef steers. Superintendents may at their discretion, break or combine classes.
5. **The Dairy Steer Show will be held Saturday, August 25th at 6:00pm.**
6. **Herdsmanship** - Special recognition will be given to the counties maintaining the most attractive and neatest pens and aisles. The total number of counties will be divided into two groups and an award presented to each group. The Herdsmanship contest will be combined with the Dairy department contest.
7. The Grand Champion Dairy Steer must be sold through the Livestock Sale. In order to sell your animal at the Livestock Sale, it must make a Daily Rate of Gain of 1.8 pounds. Please see 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale Rules found in Division X, Section XIV for additional information. Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of ONE species in the Livestock Sale.
