Division Rules & Regulations:

Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEMS FOUND AT www.marylandstatefair.com** Internet entries are due **July 31, 2018**. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release forms are due to the Maryland 4-H Center by July 31st. All exhibitors must complete and submit a release form.

- Exhibitors and exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations".
- All exhibits must be clean and free of labels and tags, unless otherwise specified in the section rules or class description.
- Judging:** All exhibits will be judged on their own merit and receive a rating of Excellent, Very Good or Good. The Judges will then at their own discretion give placings up to 10th Place in each class. Unless otherwise noted in section, exhibits will be judged in one of the 4-H Age Divisions: Junior (ages 8-10 as of 1/1/18); Intermediate (ages 11-13 as of 1/1/18); Senior (ages 14-18 as of 1/1/18). Entries not conforming to class description and/or division/section rules & regulations will be disqualified.
- Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st – 10th Place exhibits in each class. Premiums: 1st (\$7), 2nd-10th (\$5). Rosettes will be awarded to the Junior, Intermediate and Senior Champions and Reserve Champions in each section, if there are sufficient entries as determined by the Superintendent.
- Entries for this division will be received Wednesday, August 22nd from 2pm to 8pm in the 4-H/FFA Home Arts Building and released Tuesday, September 4th from 9am to 7pm. An early-bird release period will be made available on Monday, September 3rd from 8pm to 10pm AFTER the Building is closed to the public.

Section Rules & Regulations:

- EXHIBITORS WILL BE LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 4 ENTRIES IN PHOTOGRAPHY – (Example: 2 Black & White, 2 Color for a total of 4)**
- All photos must be at least 5" x 7" in size and not larger than 11" x 14", except sequence/story classes, which should be a minimum 4" x 6", max of 5" x 7" in size. (Example: buildings, flowers, people)
- All photos must be mounted on a firm mat weight board using spray adhesive, heat seal or other permanent mounting med. Use pre-cut mat if needed. **Poster Board and Foam Core is not acceptable. Do not frame the photos and do not use clips of any kind.** Photos may be mounted horizontally or vertically. Mat size should correspond to photo size:
Photo: 5" x 7" - Mat: 8" x 10" ; Photo : 8" x 10" - Mat : 11" x 14" ; Photo: 11" x 14" - Mat: 16" x 20"
- Do NOT cover photos with plastic, cellophane, or ANY other covering.**
- The following information must be printed on the upper left-hand corner of the back of the mount: Exhibitor's Name, Age, 4-H County/City and Phone. A white 3" x 5" card must be taped to the top, back, right corner of the mount. The following information must be **typed** on the card: Title of Picture; Date Picture Taken; Name of Camera; Type of Camera; Kind of Film Used. *Entries in experimental photography or digitally altered must specify what was experimental or digitally altered.
- The entry tag should be attached with string and taped to the back to hang on the right side (top front) of the photo.
- Judging:** composition (40 pts); storytelling ability; (30 pts); photo quality (20 pts); developing & printing (5 pts, except classes N9 and N23); mounting (5 pts).

Section Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitor must be enrolled in a 4-H Hobby or Craft Project or FFA Vo-Ag Instruction Unit for the current year.
2. Exhibitors must have done all work on the project. Entries that have won at a previous Maryland State Fair are not eligible for entry. Entries must be the Exhibitors' works from the current year.
3. Entries are limited to **original paintings and drawings** in all media. 3-dimensional art is not allowed. Pictures painted by numbers are not allowed. **Cartoon figures, such as Sponge Bob, Mickey Mouse, Snoopy and other copyrighted images such as Nike, Coke, McDonalds, and or business names and logos, and celebrities (living or deceased) etc. may not be used.**
4. **All exhibits must be framed and ready to hang with picture framing wire and eye hooks. All clip type poster frames will not be accepted. Paintings presented on canvas stretchers will be accepted but must be ready to hand with wire. Please do not use the following items when preparing your art for entry day – Duct tape, 3M hangers, soda tabs, thumbtacks, yarn, ribbon or string as they do not hold up on the peg board or grid. Plastic and metal framed will not be accepted unless professionally framed.**
5. Entries in this division will be received Wednesday, August 22nd from 2pm to 8pm in the 4-H/FFA Home Arts Building and released Wednesday, September 5th from 9am to 7pm.

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H Craft or Hobby Project or FFA Instructional Unit for the current year.
2. Exhibitors must have done all work on the exhibit. Where indicated with an * - an original craft is an item that has been designed, created, and prepared by the exhibitor. Entries that have won at a previous Maryland State Fair are not eligible for entry.
3. Exhibits entered in Home Environment, Clothing and Child Care will not be eligible for entry in Craft Classes. **Displays will not be accepted.**
4. Craft entries will be evaluated in terms of the following definition of a quality craft: "A quality craft reflects the craftsman's imagination and skill in creating decorative and/or useful handmade items from appropriate designs and materials."
