Instructions:

1. All trees must arrive Saturday, August 18th, 2018, time 11AM to 3PM. Trees will be judged the same day.
2. All trees must be plantation grown and must be from 5' to 8' in height from the bottom of the handle to the tip of the leader.
3. All trees must be sheared.
4. Stands will be provided. You do not have to return at close of the fair for your tree. Fair personnel and section superintendent will dispose of the exhibit.
5. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) entry per class.
6. The Fair is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

- H2 Fraser Fir
- H3 Canaan Fir
- H4 Other Fir
- H5 Blue Spruce
- H6 Other Spruce
- H7 White Pine
- H8 Other Pine

- A10 Reserve Grand Champion (DO NOT ENTER)

8. First time exhibitors will receive 50% bonus on one entry.
9. Trees will be individually scored and ranked within the classes using the following guidelines:

Foliage	Condition in regards to insect and disease 26 to 50 - Light, no damage 1 to 25 - Medium 0 - Heavy	Taper	26 to 50 – for 40% - 90% 1 to 25 – for 90% plus 0 - for 0% - 40%
Foliage Density	26 to 50 - Medium to Heavy 0 to 25 - Light	Top	26 to 50 - Right length 1 to 25 - Needlessness 1 to 25 - Too long 1 to 25 - Too short 0 - Multi-top
Foliage Freshness	1 to 25 - Fresh 0 - Dry	Merchantability	26 to 50 - Good 11 to 25 - Average 0 to 10 - Low 26 to 50 - 4 faces US premium 11 to 25 - 3 faces US premium 1 to 10 - 2 adjacent faces US grade or better
Handle	16 to 25 - Not less than 6" 1 to 15 - or more than 1 ¾ " for each foot of tree (USD Grades (4/1/73) 0 - No Handle
