### SPECIAL RULES

1. Animals not properly identified or an animal with unhealed ear notches will be ineligible for premiums.
2. There is to be ONLY 1 sow shown per family unit/farm in Class D7. All sows should show evidence of having suckled young offspring within 12 months prior to the show day.
3. **Open Swine Schedule:**
  - Pens available – 12Noon, Thursday, August 30th
  - Barrows will be weighed 1PM on Friday, August 31st
  - Must be in place – 2PM, Friday, August 31st
  - Must be checked-in – 1PM to 5PM, Friday, August 31st**
    - a. **With prior notification to open swine show superintendents, late check-in may be arranged.**
    - b. **In the case of limited pen space, animals arriving the day of show must be in place by 8AM.**
    - c. **In the case of limited pen space, animals leaving the day of show may not do so until 7PM.**
    - d. **In the case of limited pen space, each exhibitor must leave some animals in place for the duration of the open swine show weekend or their premiums will be forfeited, unless prior arrangements have been made with the open swine show superintendents.**
  - Released - 8PM, Monday, September 3rd**
4. Exhibitors are STRONGLY encouraged to give an updated head count 1 week prior to the Maryland State fair.
5. All animals must be fed inside their pen.
6. The Superintendent will assign pens.
7. There is to be no scooter riding in the barns.
8. **Registration certificates for each animal must be furnished and available anytime during the fair.** Certificates will be checked prior to show day. All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor.
9. No moneys are awarded to champions.
10. All barrows must weigh no less than 180 lbs. and no more than 310 lbs to be eligible to show.
11. Wood shavings will be the initial bedding.
12. All animals must be the property of the Exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the check in date.
13. All registration papers MUST be checked between 1PM and 5PM on Friday, August 31st, 2018 – Animals will be omitted from showing if not checked.
14. To be eligible to show crossbred Barrows, exhibitor must show purebred breeding stock.
15. Crossbred Market classes are open to Barrows only.
16. **Whether or not an individual has the ability to show a boar is up to/determined by the Superintendent or Ringman. NO person under the age of 13 is allowed to show or be present in the ring during any BOAR class (classes D1 through D6).**
17. Animals must follow NSR and/or other breed association rules for the show. Will be at the discretion of the judge and the superintendent, when the animals enter the ring.
18. Animals purchased and/or sold at a 4-H sale, during the current show season, are ineligible to show in the MD State Fair Open Class Show.
19. Champion Showman will be ineligible to show in future years.
20. There will be 1 group class entry per exhibitor.
21. There will be no more than 2 entries per class for each exhibitor.
22. **Entries for Showmanship must accompany your swine entries. NO entries will be taken on site.**
