

## DIVISION G - POULTRY

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**The fitting and preparation of all animals for exhibit is the responsibility of the Exhibitor.** Exhibitors may receive guidance only from immediate family members, Maryland 4-H/FFA Members and appointed UME Volunteers/FFA Advisors.

Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEM FOUND AT [www.marylandstatefair.com](http://www.marylandstatefair.com)** Internet entries are due July 31<sup>st</sup>. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release forms are to be completed via the online entry system at time of registration. Reminder you must have completed the online Animal Husbandry and Quality Assurance program to be able to exhibit your animals. Check with your county to make sure you are up to date with this requirement.

### Division Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitors and their exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", "Animal Rules & Regulations", the "Maryland 4-H Code of Animal Science Ethics", the "Health Regulations for Livestock Exhibited in Maryland", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations".
  - a. Substitutions will be allowed for same breed, variety, sex and age when birds are received.
  - b. Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining a "Classes of Poultry" List from their 4-H Extension Educator to assist in properly filling out the entry form. The Maryland Extension Publication 400, also available from a 4-H Extension Educator, lists the addresses for the American Poultry Association (APA) and American Bantam Association (ABA) to obtain their "Standards of Perfection".
  - c. Exhibitors are limited to entering a total of 15 birds in this division. Exhibitors may enter more than 1 bird per class. Each bird must be entered on a separate line on the entry form. Remember health papers must be presented at entry.
  - d. **Crossbred large fowl should be entered under the heavyweight or lightweight egg production classifications only.**
  - e. Any bird showing signs of disease will be refused entry. The decision of the Superintendent and/or a MD Department of Agriculture Veterinarian is final.
2. **Entries:**
  - a. **Eggs will be received in 4-H/FFA Home Arts Building from 2pm – 8pm, Wednesday, August 21. All other Poultry exhibits will be received in the South West Corner - Cow Palace on Thursday, August 22, 2019 from 4 pm until 8 pm and Friday, August 23, 2019 8 am – 10 am.**
  - b. **The 4-H Poultry show will begin at 10 am on Friday, August 23, 2019.** Exhibits will be released at the end of the show.
  - c. Please refer to the Schedule of Events for more information.
3. **Ownership:** All birds must have been owned by the Exhibitor and kept on the Exhibitor's premises on or before June 1 of the current year (unless it is a market bird – see Market Poultry section below).
4. **Judging:**
  - a. Market Poultry and Egg Production Fowl will be judged according to the criteria in the National 4-H Poultry & Egg Judging Manual.
  - b. Purebred Large Fowl will be judged by the APA's "Standards of Perfection".
  - c. Bantam Purebreds will be judged by the ABA's "Standards of Perfection".
5. Birth dates of birds are as follows:
  - a. Cocks/Hens and Old Drakes/Ducks must be hatched prior January 1 of the current year.
  - b. Cockerels/Pullets and Young Drakes/Ducks must be hatched after January 1 of the current year.
6. **All cages must be cleaned by Exhibitor and shown to the Superintendent prior to release. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of premiums.**
7. Only birds entered in the show may be brought onto the fairgrounds. **The selling of birds on the fairgrounds is NOT PERMITTED.**
8. **Awards:** Rosettes will be awarded for Section Champions in which a minimum of 25 birds must be shown. Trophies will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion in the following: Market Type, Egg Production, Large Purebred, Bantam and Duck.

### MARKET POULTRY (Section 1)

#### Section Rules & Regulations:

1. The Champion Market Poultry MUST be sold at the Livestock Sale. Reserve Champion Market Poultry will be eligible to be sold in the Livestock Sale. An exhibitor may not sell both Champion and Reserve Champion Market Poultry in the same year. Refer to State Fair 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale rules for additional information.

#### CLASSES

- G1 Market Bird Broilers Pair - **Pen of 2 matching birds 3.5 to 8 lbs. each** (each less than 7 weeks old )  
G2 Market Bird Roasters – **1 bird between 8-13 lbs.** (8-12 weeks old)  
G3 Market Bird Capons (**1 bird**) **up to 16 lbs.** (no older than 12 weeks)

### BREED POULTRY/EGG PRODUCTION (Section 2-495)

1. All eggs must be exhibited in egg cartons. Exhibitors may enter 1 entry per class.
2. Eggs must be checked in on Wednesday, August 21, 2:00pm – 8:00pm

### Section Rules & Regulations

1. 4-H'ers are invited to plan an educational exhibit to be on display during the State Fair in the 4-H/Home Arts Building. 4-H'ers will bring their exhibits to the show ring in the SW Corner of the Cow Palace on Friday, August 23, 2019 from 8am to 10am . Following the show the exhibits will be moved to the 4-H/Home Arts Building where they will be displayed for the remainder of the fair. Exhibits can be picked up from 8pm to 10pm on Monday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> or from 9am to 7pm on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The exhibit may be an informational poster or other educational display. Youth and adults working together is encouraged. Contact the Superintendent for more info. Each Exhibitor may enter 2 exhibits.
2. 4-H Members carrying a Poultry, Rabbit or Cavy project in the current year are eligible to participate. A \$5 Participation Premium will be paid.
