Baltimore County Department of Health Providing COVID-19 Vaccinations during Maryland State Fair

Baltimore County, Maryland — Known for fun rides, great exhibits and delicious food, this year the Maryland State Fair will also be a convenient location to get a quick and easy COVID-19 vaccination. The Baltimore County Department of Health will be on site in the Exhibition Hall every day of the fair to provide the safe and effective Pfizer vaccine to anyone age 12 and over.

“We continue our goal of making the vaccine available to anyone who wants it, especially as we know that getting vaccinated is our number one defense against the spread of the virus,” said Baltimore County Health Officer Dr. Gregory Wm. Branch. “The State Fair is traditionally enjoyed as a summer family outing. We hope to take advantage of this tradition and look forward to vaccinating family groups visiting the fairgrounds.”

The vaccination clinic will be located in the Exhibition Hall. Fairgoers can receive their vaccine Monday through Friday from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays, Sundays and Labor Day Monday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. The Pfizer vaccine, a two-dose regimen, will be administered and information on second dose locations will be provided.
