Concert Venue Information

Directions:

Physical Location: 2200 York Road, Lutherville, MD 21093

From points South, East and West: I-83 North to Exit 17 – East Padonia Rd., bear Right off of Exit, Right (south) on York Road to Fairgrounds on right.

From points North: I-83 South to Exit 17 – East Padonia Rd., Left at light, Right (south) on York Road to Fairgrounds on right.

Concert Infield Hours:

Concert goers will be admitted into Concert Gates starting at 6:30 PM for all concerts. Concerts begin at 7:30 PM.

Parking:

Onsite parking is limited. Fairgoers are strongly encouraged to use the Light Rail or other forms of public transportation. UBER/LYFT drop off and pick up location is on the Deereco Road Park and Ride Lot. Patrons may then enter the fairgrounds through the Light Rail admission gate.

Public Transportation (Busses, MTA, Light Rail, UBER/LYFT)

Limited parking is available on the Fairgrounds for \$5. Free parking is available at the Park and Ride location on Deereco Road, West of the Fairgrounds. Parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Handicapped parking is available. Please see the fairgrounds parkers, and they will direct you to the appropriate and closest handicapped parking area. Because convenient parking is limited, we encourage the use of the Light Rail. UBER/LYFT drop off and pick up location is on the Deereco Road Park and Ride Lot. Patrons may then enter the fairgrounds through the Light Rail admission gate.

Children's Rules:

All children 3 and over require a paid concert ticket to be admitted to the concerts.

Special Needs:

All concert goers requiring special assistance must assemble at the Main Gate, under the Maryland State Fair marquee/electronic sign at 6:30PM. To gain admittance to the handicap parking area, it will be required to have and present to security, concert ticket and handicap credentials. The Main Gate Area can be accessed ONLY from York Road (heading South), adjacent to Timonium/Giant shopping center. From the Main Gate Area, you will be escorted into the Racetrack Infield where the concert will take place. Special Needs seating is limited, so only one guest (also with paid concert ticket) may accompany the guest in need of special assistance.

General Rules for Grounds and Concert Venue:

For the safety and comfort of our patrons and exhibitors:

Permissible items on Grounds include:

Blankets, Cellular Phones, Cameras (up to 35mm), Binoculars, Sunscreen, Strollers.
Back Bags/backpacks, not exceeding 18 x 18 inches
Coolers, not exceeding 15 x 15 x 15 inches
Child/diaper bags, clear bags if possible
Medical equipment i.e. oxygen tanks, medical devices
NOTE: Chairs are permitted during concerts, but not encouraged.

Non-permissible on Grounds:

Drones
Alcoholic beverages
Fireworks
Weapons, including but not limited to guns, knives, scissors, stun guns, tasers, brass knuckles, etc.
Selfie sticks
Duffle bags
Mace/Pepper spray
Hoverboards/Segways

The Following Items are NOT permitted in the Racetrack Infield:

Food or beverages purchased outside of the fairgrounds, liquor or drugs of any kind, guns, knives, weapons of any kind, fireworks, explosives, glass containers of any type, bottles, cans, coolers, large bags, thermoses, tents, grills, ladders, scaffolding or other raised devices, bulk or oversized carrying devices, handcarts, wheeled carts, lawn chairs (NOTE: Lawn Chairs are permitted during concerts.), umbrellas, wagons, in-line skates, skateboards, kites, frisbees, laser pointers, pets, radios and professional recording devices of any kind. Persons entering the facility may be subject to search for contraband, as well as professional recording devices (cameras, video equipment etc.) which are expressly forbidden on facility premises and subject to confiscation.

The Maryland State Fair reserves the right, without any refund of the ticket purchase price, to refuse admission to or eject any person whose conduct is deemed by The Maryland State Fair to be disorderly, who is in possession of drugs, or who is under the age of 21 and possesses alcohol.

The Maryland State Fair reserves the right to confiscate any such item(s), which will not be returned.

All persons entering The Maryland State Fairgrounds and their camera bags, purses and containers are subject to direct/indirect physical search.

Demonstrations, protests, vigils of any nature are prohibited on the grounds and premises of The Maryland State Fairgrounds, during The Maryland State Fair, and during any and all events and functions.

The Maryland State Fair reserves the right to alter carry-in policies at any time.

Traffic Patterns:

During the Maryland State Fair, ONLY right turns into the Fairgrounds from Timonium Road and York Roads are permitted.
