Application Procedures

1. Complete the Application Form. Attach separate sheets of paper if needed.
2. Write two essays, each essay not to exceed two double spaced pages. Choose from the following topics:
 - What programs or activities can Maryland State Fair offer to fairgoers that would enhance their experience of attending the fair?
 - What in your opinion are the biggest misconceptions about agriculture?
 - What programs in 4-H or FFA have had the most impact on you? Have these programs influenced your career choices?
 - You have the opportunity to be a guide to a non-farm family as they attend the Maryland State Fair for the first time. Name three areas of the fair you would definitely want to direct them to and why?
3. Attach copies of high school grade transcripts, Standardized Test scores, and any other relevant information.
4. Send completed Application to: F. Grove Miller Maryland State Fair Scholarship Program, P.O. Box 188, Timonium, MD 21094-0188.
5. Deadline for receipt of Application is July 1, 2019.
6. Application must be typed.
7. The applicant must be a permanent resident of the State of Maryland and an active participant in the 2019 Maryland State Fair. The F. Grove Miller Maryland State Fair Scholarship can only be won a maximum of 2 times by the same individual.
8. Proof of enrollment in an accredited college or university must be presented to the Maryland State Fair Office by October 1 of the academic year in which the Scholarship is awarded.
