The fitting and preparation of all animals for exhibit is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors may receive guidance only from immediate family members, Maryland 4-H/FFA Members and appointed UME Volunteers/FFA Advisors.

### Division Rules & Regulations:

- Exhibitors and their exhibits must comply with the "General State Fair Rules & Regulations", "General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations", "Animal Rules & Regulations", the "Maryland 4-H Code of Animal Science Ethics", the "Health Regulations for Livestock Exhibited in Maryland", these "Division Rules & Regulations" and the applicable "Section Rules & Regulations".

Pre-entry is required. **YOU MUST USE THE INTERNET ENTRY SYSTEMS FOUND AT [www.marylandstatefair.com](http://www.marylandstatefair.com)** Internet entries are due **July 31st**. Exhibitors without internet access should contact their County Extension Educator for assistance. All release forms are to be completed via the online entry system at time of registration. **After online entry, you will receive via mail an exhibitor letter and an attachment (show entry form) with instructions that must be returned to the Superintendent prior to the show.** Reminder you must have completed the Animal Husbandry & Quality Assurance program to be able to exhibit your animals. Check with your county to make sure you are up to date with this requirement.

**Entries for the 4-H Cavy Show will be received at the South End of the Cow Palace Building from 8:00 am on Saturday, August 27, 2022. The 4-H Cavy Show will begin at 10 am. This will be a carrier show with animals being released at end of the show or as allowed by the Superintendent.**

All cavy exhibitors must fill out a [Self Certification of Rabbit Health](#) prior to loading animals at home and shall be presented upon request to the designated fair and show representative upon arrival at the show. The required form may be found on the Maryland Department of Agriculture website at <https://mda.maryland.gov/AnimalHealth/Pages/Fairs-Shows.aspx>

- Substitutions will be allowed in the same group, variety, age and sex on the day of the show.
  - All exhibits must be a breed recognized by ARBA. Mixed breeds are not allowed. The book, "Standard of Perfection" outlines the standards for each recognized breed. It can be ordered online at [www.arba.net](http://www.arba.net) or by calling (814) 297-8233. Exhibitors are responsible for obtaining an ARBA Standard or List of Breeds & Colors from their 4-H Extension Educator to assist in properly filling out the entry form.
  - Exhibitors are limited to seven (7) entries in the breed classes. (If showing both Rabbits and Cavies, exhibitors may enter seven (7) animals in each species.)
  - Cavies must have numbered ear tags.**
  - Any exhibit displaying signs of disease or in poor fleshing condition will be refused entry. The decision of the Superintendent is final.
- Ownership:** All cavies must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor by June 1 of the current year.
  - Judging:** This is an official American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) sanctioned show. However, if a dual licensed judge is not available, a non-ARBA judge/individual will judge and place the entries. If this occurs, ARBA legs will not be issued. Show classes are listed as: Junior Boars & Sows - 12 oz. to 22 oz., Intermediate Boars & Sows - 23oz. to 32 oz., Senior Boars and Sows - over 32 oz.
  - Spectators, including family members/friends of Exhibitor, will only be allowed to observe the judging table from a reasonable distance as determined by the Superintendent. No one will be allowed in the cage area during judging except carriers and Exhibitors.
  - Only cavies entered in the show may be brought onto the fairgrounds. **The selling of cavies on the fairgrounds is NOT PERMITTED.**
  - Rosettes will be awarded for Best of Breed in all breed classes.

### SHOWMANSHIP (Section 14)

#### Section Rules & Regulations:

- Pre-entry is required. Please see above for entry details.** Exhibitors will compete according to their 4-H Age (age as of 1/1/22) except for those entering in the Novice class (1<sup>st</sup> project year participating in Showmanship). Superintendent may, at their discretion, split classes.
- Cavy used must be entered in the State 4-H Cavy show and be owned by the Exhibitor competing in this section.
- There will be a 15-minute limit on presentations. Exhibitor's knowledge may be tested by answering questions related to the breed exhibited, diseases and standard management practices.

### EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS (Section 15)

#### Section Rules & Regulations:

- 4-H'ers may plan an educational exhibit to display during the State Fair in the 4-H/Home Arts Building. **4-H'ers will bring their exhibits to the South End of the Cow Palace on Saturday, August 27, 2022 from 9am to 10am.** Following the show, the exhibits will be moved to the 4-H/Home Arts Building to be displayed for the remainder of the fair (or you may take the exhibit home with you). Exhibits can be picked up from 8pm to 10pm on Sunday, September 11th or from 9am to 7pm on Monday, September 12th. The exhibit may be an informational poster or other educational display. Each exhibitor may enter two (2) exhibits.
- 4-H Members carrying a Cavy project in the current year are eligible to participate. A \$5 Participation Premium will be paid.
