Team Purebred Eastern Regional Schedule:

Must be in place – 2PM, Friday, September 2nd

Must be checked-in & weighed-in 1PM– 5PM, Friday, September 2nd

Skill-a-thon will begin at 10AM, Saturday, September 3rd

Released – 6PM, Sunday, September 4th

Eligibility:

1. All exhibitors and participants must be members of Team Purebred.
2. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2022.
3. The age divisions will be as of January 1, 2022: Senior (17-21); Intermediate (13-16); Junior (9-12) and Novice (8 and under).
4. If an exhibitor is not present to show their barrow/gilt, the hog cannot be exhibited without prior approval from the Director of Jr. Activities.
5. YQCA certification is required for ALL exhibitors or their parents or guardians. YQCA Numbers to be presented at check-in. YQCA training is available online at www.yqcaprogram.org.org. PQA training is also available online at www.pork.org.

Requirements:

1. Gilt & barrow entries must be registered swine farrowed January 1, 2022 and after. All Purebred gilts will be shown by age. All Crossbred gilts will be shown by weight.
2. Crossbred barrows & gilts may show and be entered. For each crossbred entry, you **MUST enter and EXHIBIT a purebred animal barrow or gilt**. *1 for 1 rule (1 Purebred for 1 Crossbred)*.
3. Entries may be purchased animals, but must be owned by the junior exhibitor, the exhibitor's family name, or exhibitor's farm name (on or before **July 3, 2022**). Entries must be registered and/or transferred prior to the show.
4. Junior exhibitors must bring their original pedigree and a **copy of their pedigree** to check-in. We will check the original and return it to you; however, we will keep the copy to use during the shows. Substitutions will be allowed at the show.
5. All health rules must be followed or animals will not be allowed on the grounds. Bring your original health papers to check in with you.
6. All pens are assigned. No moving or switching of pen cards at the show. Our penning system allows us to find participants quickly if any problems or special needs arise throughout the weekend.
7. All entries must arrive by 2:00 PM on Friday, September 2nd. All entries must be weighed and checked-in by 5:00 PM on Friday, September 2nd. All barrows will be weighed and divided into classes of approximately equal number. Animals will be omitted from showing if not checked in. Late arrivals must be pre-approved by Team Purebred.
8. There will be designated trailer parking areas. Please look for signs posted around the barn. Trailers parked around or near the barn may be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
9. Team Purebred & Maryland State Fair reserves the right to randomly collect a DNA sample on exhibited animals (barrows and gilts) at any event where registered animals are exhibited. This sample may be used for testing for the presence of the stress gene, sire verification, or breed purity. This collection will be supervised by Team Purebred or breed representatives. We may withhold premiums on Champions and Reserves until all tests are conclusive. Chester White, Poland, Spotted, Hereford and Tamworth breed champions and reserves will be DNA tested for parentage.
10. No clipping will be allowed in the barns at Team Purebred competitions.
11. Team Purebred reserves the right to collect samples for drug testing on any animal exhibited. By submitting entries, the exhibitor acknowledges this and agrees to comply if selected. Information & Schedule for the Eastern Regional:

1. The cost per head (Classes D10 through D43, excluding Champion Classes) is \$45. There is NO cost for Showmanship classes or Skill-A-Thon classes. Both Showmanship and Skill-A-Thon classes can also be entered on the day of the show. If someone is not showing an animal, and they wish to participate in Judging, Showmanship and Skill-A-Thon, they will need to pay a participation fee of \$5. The \$5 participation fee can be paid the day of the show.
2. The Photo Judging and Skill-A-Thon Contests will be held Saturday, September 3rd from 10AM to 3PM. The exact location will be posted Friday and announced at the show during the day Saturday. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to find time to take the Skill-A-Thon and place the judging classes. Judging classes will be designed specifically for each age group. Prizes will be awarded to the top three in each age division.
3. There will be a Sweepstakes contest for exhibitors showing, and participating in showmanship, judging and the Skill-A-Thon contests. Exhibitors must participate in all events to be eligible. The Sweepstakes awards are sponsored by THE MILL.
4. Showmanship will start at 6:00 PM, Friday, September 2nd. We will show youngest to oldest. Prizes will be awarded to the top three in each age division.
5. Maryland State Fair will pay up to 6 places per class, 1st - \$40, 2nd - \$35, 3rd - \$30, 4th - \$25, 5th - \$20, and 6th - \$15.
6. Breed Champion Barrows & Gilts receive \$250, a plaque, and a banner. Breed Reserve Champions Barrows & Gilts receive \$125 and a banner. Champion dollars all originate from Team Purebred. ***Breed champion and reserves must have their picture taken with the official Team Purebred event photographer to receive premiums. Failure to have your photo taken will forfeit all premiums.*** Photos will be published in the *Breeders Digest* magazine with the Eastern Regional results report.
7. There will be a Top 5 Overall Purebred barrows and gilts selected. Each will receive a banner.
8. Barrow Show will start at approximately 5 PM, Saturday, September 3rd. We will show in alphabetical breed order, with Crossbreds being last. (Chester White, Hereford, Poland, Spotted, Tamworth and Crossbreds).
9. Gilt show will be held Sunday, September 4th at 9AM. We will show in alphabetical breed order, with Crossbreds being last.
10. The Skill-A-Thon, judging and sweepstakes awards will be handed out following the Grand Champion Team Purebred Gilt drive on Sunday, September 4th.
11. Please read the health requirements closely. We cannot allow you to exhibit if you do not follow health rules, which can be found on our website at www.MarylandStateFair.com. Call for details if you are not sure of these rules.
12. Special prizes and events will be held throughout the weekend. Please monitor the website for exact details as the event gets closer.
13. Team Purebred animals are released 6:00 PM, Sunday, September 4th.
14. Please remember that we only provide initial bedding and that all additional bedding is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
15. All animals must be fed inside their pen.
16. **Bedding will be wood shavings only. The initial bedding will be supplied by the Fair, additional bedding is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their pens; prior to leaving all exhibitors must check-out with a superintendent. Exhibitors not cleaning their pens will forfeit all premiums.**
